FROM THE EAST

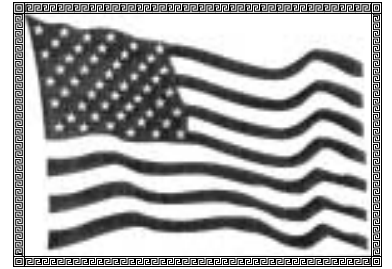
