**PROPOSED BY-LAWS AMENDMENT FOR
BOYNTON LODGE NO 236 F.& A.M.**

THE SECTION BELOW "13.04" WILL BE ADDED TO OUR BY-LAWS UNDER LODGE FUNDS

13.04 Lodge Endowment Fund – There is hereby established a fund to be designated the Endowment Fund of Boynton Lodge No 236 Free and Accepted Masons of Florida. The principal amount thereof shall not be expended for any purpose or purposes whatsoever save for investment and reinvestment. Fifty percent (50%) of the interest income derived therefrom may, in case of necessity, be expended for the use of the following year’s budget of Boynton Lodge No 236 Free and Accepted Masons of Florida. If said interest income is not necessary for the operation of the lodge and hence not used the following year, the unused balance thereof shall become an integral part of the principal. In the event a need is determined, all, or a portion of the remaining fifty percent may only be disbursed when a proposition justifying and documenting the expense is made in writing at a Stated Communication. After discussion, and if approved by majority vote, the matter shall lie over to the next Stated Communication. The membership shall be given written notice thereof, and if three-fourth of all the members of the Lodge then present vote by a secret written ballot in favor thereof, the said disbursement can be made.

The management of said fund shall be the responsibility of the Finance Committee. Said Finance Committee shall be open to and consider suggestions and recommendations from the Craft with regard to investment decisions prior to their implementation. Said Finance Committee and shall maintain an investment strategy which adheres to a conservative approach characteristic for an endowment fund of this nature.

At the end of each fiscal year, the Lodge’s unrestricted operational accounts shall be evaluated after all the current’s year’s expenses have been fully satisfied. Any excess funds shall be transferred to the Endowment Fund leaving sufficient capital to maintain the effective operation of the Lodge for the next fiscal year.

All bequests or donations made to the Lodge which have been specifically designated for the Endowment Fund shall, upon receipt, be immediately placed in said fund. Donations specifically earmarked for the Building or Scholarship Fund shall continue to be placed in the respective account and shall not be co-mingled with one another or the Endowment Fund itself.

After giving written notice to the craft, at the first Stated Communication of the year, the Worshipful Master or the Senior Warden, as chairman of the Finance Committee shall present a realistic and balanced budget for the ensuing year’s income/expenses as compared to the prior year’s income and expenses. Copies of said budget will be provided to the Brethren present, voted upon, and approved.
