**AMENDEMENT TO SECTION "10.06" AND
ADDITIONAL PROVISION TO THE BY-LAWS Section 13.05 and 13.06
THE SECTION BELOW "10.06" WILL BE AMENDED AND THE SECTIONS
BELOW "13.05 and 13.06" WILL BE ADDED TO OUR BY-LAWS UNDER
LODGE FUNDS**

10.06 Scholarship Committee- The Worshipful Master shall appoint at least three members of the Lodge to the Scholarship Committee. The duty of this committee will be to select recipients for said scholarships as the committee sees fit. The amount of the scholarship must be in accordance with section 13.05 of the By-Laws (Lodge Scholarship Fund) and approved by the Craft.

13.05 Lodge Scholarship Fund – There is hereby established a fund to be designated the Scholarship Fund of Boynton Lodge No 236 Free and Accepted Masons of Florida. The principal amount thereof shall not be expended for any purpose or purposes whatsoever save for investment and reinvestment. The sum of \$500.00 per \$10,000.00 of invested principal in said Scholarship Fund shall be disbursed for scholarships each year. The Management of said Lodge Scholarship Fund shall be consistent with the provision enumerated in Section 13.04 above.

13.06 Building Fund – There is hereby established a fund to be designated the Building Fund of Boynton Lodge No 236 Free and Accepted Masons of Florida. The Principal amount thereof shall not be expended for any purpose or purposes whatsoever save that for the following:
1- Investment and reinvestment
2- Maintenance and building repairs
3- Reconstruction –Should the Lodge building be partially or completely destroyed by fire, flood, storm or any other form of damage, the principal from said Building Fund may be used to pay the insurance deductible or to make the necessary repairs.
The management of said Lodge Building Fund shall be consistent with the provisions enumerated in Section 13.04 above.
