## Freemasonry and Revolution

Presented at the Lodge meeting February 10th, 2011

*In the Lodge, we are taught that two topics of discussion that we are forbidden to discuss in Lodge are Religion and Politics. We are charged to be dutiful citizens, obedient to the lawful government. This caused me to wonder why so many revolutionary movements have been led by Freemasons. The American Revolution had many Brethren involved (and not just on the American side!). Founding Fathers were not all members of the Fraternity, but even many of those who are not proven to be Brothers still shared a lot of the same philosophies. The Civil War could be looked at as a revolution, and this conflict also had a large number of Brothers involved on both sides.*

*In Europe, the growth of Freemasonry also paralleled the growth of Revolutionary movements, bringing power from the elite (the King, or the Church) to the people. The French Revolution had significant numbers of Brothers involved, although the theories linking the entire thing to either the Freemasons or the Illuminati (a movement that started in Bavarian Lodges) have largely been discredited. The Unification of Italy and the decrease of Papal power had a Mason at the forefront.*

*In the Western Hemisphere, the revolutions that freed substantial portions of land from the rule of the French (Haiti) and the Spanish (Colombia, Panama, Venezuela, and Ecuador) were led by members of the Fraternity.*

*I conclude that many who would become Freemasons feel that the rights of the individual trump that of the State, and these men are willing to fight to protect those rights.*
