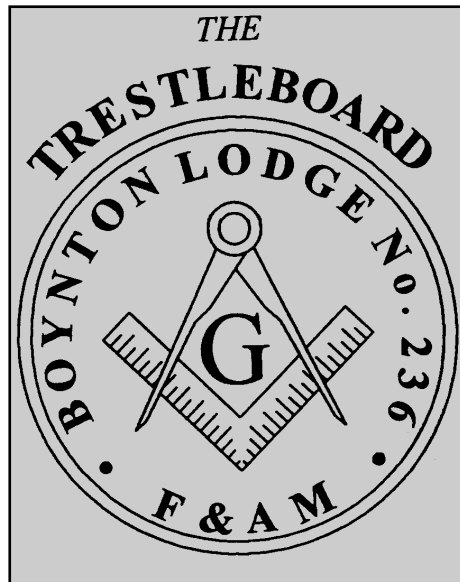

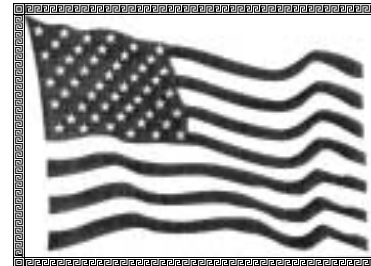
An entourage of approximately twenty recently returned from a
