Brethren,

July 3rd, 1863, may mark one of the most powerful expressions of Brotherly Love in the history of the Craft. On this date, during a particularly bloody skirmish of the Battle of Gettysburg known as Pickett's Charge, Major General Winfield Scott Hancock led Union forces against those of Confederate Brigadier General Lewis Addison Armistead. Both men were Freemasons and had been friends before the Civil War. Both generals were severely wounded at about the same time, and as Brother Armistead fell, he presented a sign that would be familiar to Master Masons. The sign was recognized by Captain Henry H. Bingham, who was also a Brother. Despite being on opposite sides in a bloody battle during a very divisive civil war, Brother Bingham rushed to the aid of his wounded Brother, who reportedly asked to speak with his old friend and Brother, General Hancock. Bingham informed Armistead that Hancock, too, had been wounded in battle, but helped him off the field and to a hospital. To this day, there is a powerful statue at the Gettysburg National Cemetery, know as the "Friend to Friend Masonic Memorial" commemorating this event, which is also dramatized during degree ritual in at least one Masonic body. In fact, I was honored to portray General Hancock in such a degree in the Scottish Rite, Northern Masonic Jurisdiction.

As we see divisiveness grow once again in our country, let us remember this example of Brotherly Love and that the sublime principles of Freemasonry, which have existed since time immemorial, supersede any transitory political movements. More especially, help us to remember that no contention should ever exist among Brothers except that of who can best work, and who can best agree. Fraternally,
